The key to comfort in Anchorage is to dress in layers. Comfortable walking shoes and warm socks are appropriate for all seasons.

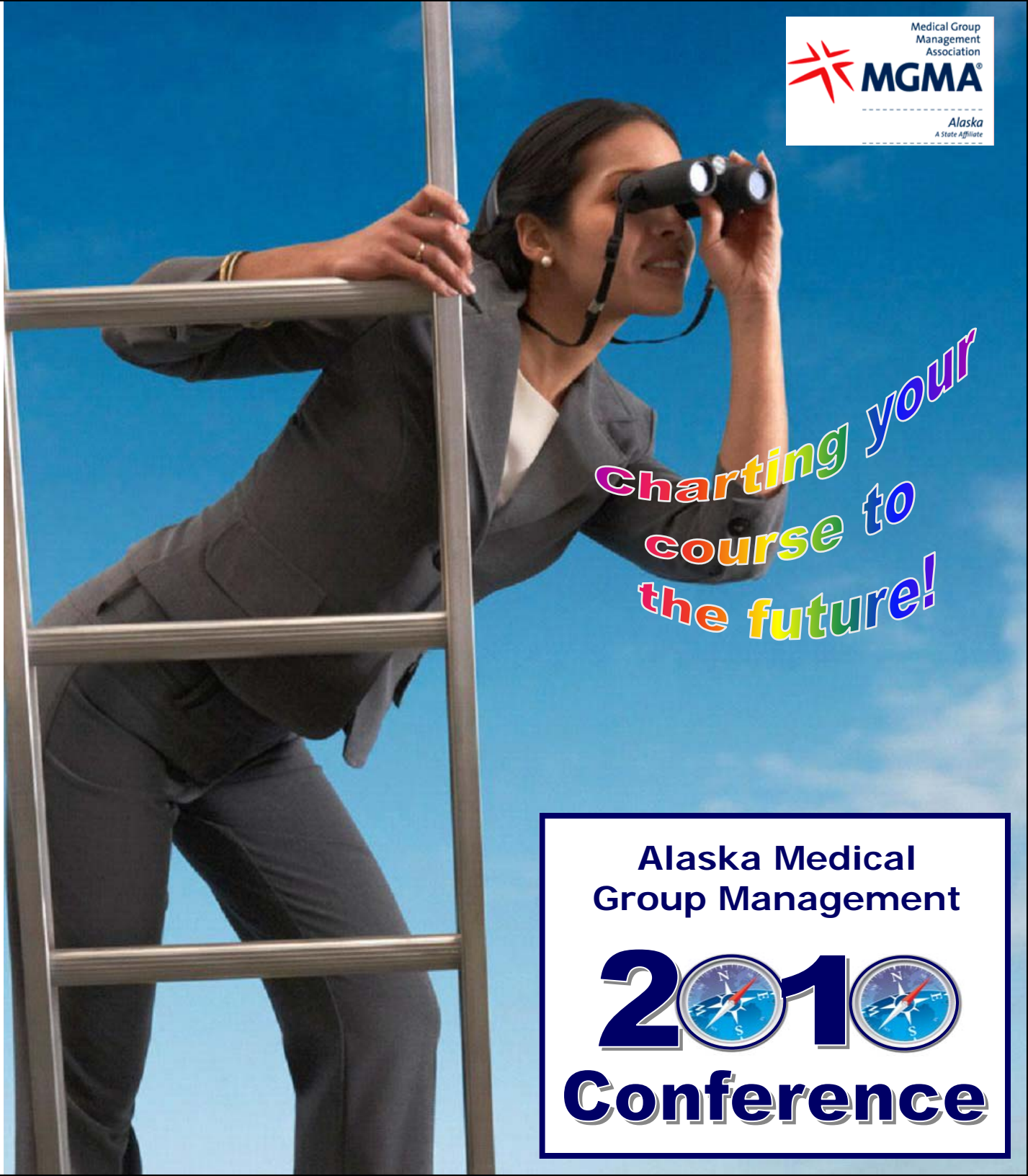
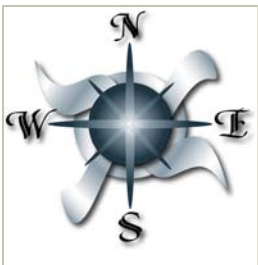
**Activities:**
